GENERAL HINTS AND TIPS

- 1. If you have difficult shapes to decorate:
 - a) Warm the ware. This makes the decal softer on contact.
 - b) Slightly increase the water temperature in the decorating bowl.
- 2. If you see a halo or "ghost" around the decal after firing:
 - a) Check the decorating water is clean.
 - b) Have you fired at the correct temperature?
 - c) Was the kiln correctly ventilated?
- 3. To store the decal sheets in good condition:
 - a) Store in a dry place.
 - b) Do not store near sources of heat or light.
 - c) Do not store in cold areas.
 - d) We recommend storing at 60 70 F
- 4. If you live in areas of hard water it can be beneficial to add just the slightest drop of washing liquid. Do not add more than a drop as this can dissolve the adhesive gum from the paper.
